

The Longridge Partnership

From the 2005 Action Plan the following Actions have been achieved.

- Action 2: Support the development of a Social Enterprise Company in Longridge
- Action 4: *Investigate the potential to increase the provision of affordable housing in the Longridge area*
- Action 5: *Improve the marketing and promotion of Longridge*
- Action 6: *Improve and extend the retail offer in Longridge to revitalise the town centre and create a greater sense of place*
- Action 12: *Investigate the potential to implement traffic calming along Mardale Road and in other residential locations in the town*
- Action 13: *Provide real time information and bus shelters at bus stops and ensure buses are clean and accessible to the mobility impaired*
- Action 15: *Improve directional signage within the town to improve legibility*
- Action 16: *Improve existing footpaths and street lighting*
- Action 20: *Improve existing public toilets and extend opening hours*
- Action 21: *Increase access to NHS dental provision*
- Action 22: *Investigate the potential to implement a permanent CCTV scheme in the town centre*
- Action 23: *Investigate the potential to develop childcare facilities*
- Action 25: *Undertake a feasibility study into the development of a Heritage Centre in Longridge*

- Action 26: Introduce interpretation boards and directional signage along the Longridge Heritage Trails and Six Long Walks around Longridge routes*
- Action 28: Establish a Community Environmental Action Team to tackle 'Grot Spots' within the town*
- Action 29: Introduce a confidential information and advice drop-in session for young people at Longridge Youth and Community Centre*
- Action 30: Construct a number of youth shelters at agreed locations within the town*
- Action 32: Improve existing play areas*
- Action 33: Support the development of a skatepark*
- Action 34: Ensure young people are involved in all projects and activities, which affect them*
